At CC:DA's Midwinter meeting, it was requested that the groups submitting changes to Chapter 7 rules on chief source of information submit a revised paper with discussion points for the CC:DA listserv. The paper has been submitted. Discussion points are as follows:

1. 7.0B2: If 7.0B1 is to be changed, that impacts 7.0B2's prescribed sources of information listed under 1) Edition, 2) Publication, distribution, etc., and 3) Series. Add "Information on the item itself (other than the title frames)" under those three areas.

Standard number and terms of availability	Any source

2. 7.7B22: Remove the date clause under proposed 7.7B22 optional rule ("If desired, record the date viewed") and remove the date from the example. The date clause brings Chapter 7 in conformance with Chapter 9, but serves no other purpose if the title is a physical resource where the content is fixed. Although archives often record the date a physical item was viewed, that date usually (and more properly) appears in conjunction with condition notes.
